

RISKS OF COSMETIC TREATMENTS

I understand the risks of the following treatments include, but are not limited to:

FOR ALL TREATMENTS:

- Zero or minimal improvement of the condition.
- No guarantee of results.

CHEMICAL PEELS and MICRODERMABRASION:

- Swelling, redness, peeling, mild scabbing and scarring.
- The improvement of the condition may take several treatments to be accomplished.

BOTOX:

- Temporary headache, swelling, bruising, pain during injection, twitching, itching, numbness, asymmetry (unevenness), temporary drooping of eyelids or eyebrows and temporary weakness of hand strength (for palmar hyperhidrosis only).

FILLERS (Collagen, Restylane, Hylaform, Hylaform Plus):

- Temporary swelling, redness, bruising and tenderness around the treatment sites. In less than 1% of cases, there have been reports of inflammatory reactions or bacterial infections which may result in redness and nodules (bumps) in the skin. In these rare cases, these effects typically resolve within a few weeks.

LASER:

- Redness, swelling, scabbing, crusting, blisters, infection, pain, discoloration of the skin, scarring and recurrence of the underlying condition. Sun sensitivity for 2 - 12 weeks.
- For treatment of unwanted hair, the hair removal process is not considered permanent. Although studies have shown a 60-85% reduction in hair density after the completion of 6 - 10 treatments, there is no guarantee of these results.
- The improvement of the condition may take several treatments to be accomplished.
